Submission Specifications:

Please ensure the following is included with your submission, which must be in .doc format:

- An Author's Bio (1-2 paragraphs) describing any publications, education, websites, ongoing research, etc.
- An image related to the content of the post. The size must be 300 by 400 pixels, and a specific source must be included.
- 2-3 quotes from the submission, to be included at the end of the submission.
- Comma-separated tags at the bottom of the post based on what the post is about: e.g., Egypt, revolution, protests, art.
- Hyperlink words in the article if they refer to links on the internet.
- We encourage hyperlinked names in the article when quoting or referencing instead of formal citations. Please avoid footnotes & embed them as hyperlinks if possible.
- Sign and email the copyright Release Form (download [here](#)).

Review Process:

O.M.A.R.'s editorial team, collectively reviews all submissions. If an article needs further work, a team member will contact the author. This process can take anywhere from several hours to several weeks depending on the extent of proposed revisions.

Checklist for Submissions:

- ✓ Author's Bio
- ✓ Submit an image related to the content of the post
- ✓ Hyperlink words in your article if they refer to links on the internet.
- ✓ Select 2-3 quotes from your post.
- ✓ Include comma-separated tags based on what your post is about.
